

III. Faculty of Arts Award for Leadership in Internationalization

The Faculty of Arts Award for Internationalization recognizes faculty members who have shown leadership in one or more areas that contribute to the goals identified in the Internationalization Strategy of the University of Calgary (<http://www.ucalgary.ca/uci/system/files/International+strategy-final-sm.pdf>). The award seeks to recognize outstanding achievements in the areas of:

- Establishment of academic networks with international partners,
- International research collaborations,
- Internationalization of the curriculum,
- International development projects,
- Promotion of overseas mobility for both staff and students,
- Involvement with international students on campus,
- Development of cross-cultural competencies among University of Calgary domestic students,
- Mentorship of colleagues or students in the above internationalization activities,
- Leadership in community and public engagement.

Consideration will be given to the breadth of involvement of the nominee in internationalization, the level of innovation, the length of time, and the impact of these activities.

Faculty and staff members will make nominations for the Leadership Award in Internationalization annually. Continuing and limited-term faculty members in the Faculty of Arts are eligible. The nomination package should include:

- A nomination letter that outlines activities that have strengthened internationalization across a discipline or academic unit, across a number of academic units within the university, or in the community,
- A copy of the nominee's CV, (abbreviated)
- Details of the nominee's internationalization efforts, activities, and projects.

Awards will be given in the following categories:

- a) Individual faculty member (***One award per year***).

Application packages should not exceed ten (10) pages.
