

What is Co-op?

- Work-Integrated Learning Program
- Full-time, paid positions that normally alternate with academic semesters
- 3-way Partnership: Student/Employer/University
- 3 work terms for designation = 12 – 16 months work experience
 - Adds approximately one year to your degree
 - Does not count as credit towards courses required for your degree





Benefits of Co-op



- Develop workplace skills
- Build references
 - Network with professionals



- Earn income
- Explore career options
- Enhanced learning



How Does Co-op Work?



- Apply (Oct. 15), application will be reviewed some exceptions if you have questions contact <u>artscoop@ucalgary.ca</u>
- 2. Receive letter of acceptance mid late November with assigned Co-op Coordinator/Advisor
- 3. Complete mandatory workshops (online options)
- 4. Resume approved before applying for co-op jobs
- 5. Network, apply for positions online Elevate portal and external positions
- 6. Resources and support: your Co-op Team and online on D2L
- 7. Competitive process no placement guarantee
- 8. Stay registered in courses plan B!

Elevate



- Once accepted to the Co-op program, Co-op students gain access to the Arts Co-op jobs on Elevate

Co-op Application



- To apply go to: <u>https://elevate.ucalgary.ca/home.htm</u>
- Log in
- Faculty of Arts on left menu > Arts Co-op
- Choose your Program of Study from list
- If application not visible, contact the Co-op program for assistance
- Include letter, resume, sequence for work terms
- Complete application form and submit

What you need to apply



- GPA 2.5 (last 10 courses, 30 units excluding courses currently registered in)
- Full-time student; declared major that offers Co-op
- Complete 10 courses or 30 units by application
- Typically apply second year, start work term in third year; normally, not more than 20 courses or 60 units at time of application
- Recommend that you have completed 5 courses in major prior to first placement
- Some exceptions with combined degrees
- Transfer students may be eligible (ideally, 20 courses remaining in degree at time of application)
- Each application is reviewed individually

Example of Schedule with Co-op * at least one work term must be in Fall or Winter

Fees, Loans, Wages

- \$50 non-refundable fee once you approve acceptance
- When on a work term registration in Co-op 511.0#
- Tuition cost for 1 course + General student fees

 check <u>Academic Calendar</u> for exact amounts
- Considered full-time student, loans not repayable while in Co-op term
- What to expect as pay for Co-op jobs

Considerations



- You can find your own Co-op work term if it meets the criteria (full time, paid, 12-16 weeks, related to your degree(s) and/or career goals and provides adequate supervision)
- Some international internship opportunities may count as a Co-op term (e.g. Washington Centre Internship, Queen Elizabeth II Diamond Jubilee Internships)
- International travel for Co-op is permitted.
 The U of C closely follows the Government of Canada travel restrictions and regulations.

Acceptance



- Apply via Elevate by October 15 a system generated confirmation of application received.
- You will be notified by email by end of November, or earlier if possible, of your application status
- If accepted, you will be notified, asked if you want to accept offer, and provided a workshop schedule, including an Orientation session and registered in D2L course with online resources and options.

Key Points



- **\$50 non-refundable administrative fee** when accepted into program
- When on a work term assessed tuition + general student fees for one course
- Co-op will extend your degree
- Co-op courses are Credit/Fail and count towards your Co-op Designation – not your degree
- While on a work term you are considered a full-time student and you can only take 1 academic course (that doesn't interrupt your work day)
- To pass Co-op course all assignments must be completed and a 'Satisfactory' evaluation received from employer
