Call for Initiatives

The Language Research Centre (LRC) supports academic and professional development events organized by its members. Eligible events are those that focus on the discussion and dissemination of scholarship or on the training of skills in the areas of language teaching and learning, literary and cultural studies, or theoretical and experimental linguistics. Priority will be given to events that benefit graduate students. Members can request funds of up to \$2,000 CAD. Members can receive funding for multiple initiatives, but the Steering Committee will aim to support requests across the various disciplines represented in the LRC. Requests will be accepted between April and December 2022, for events between April 2022 and February 2023. Requests will be considered on a rolling basis by the LRC Steering Committee.

Interested members of the LRC are asked to provide a brief description of the planned event (approximately 250-500 words). This statement should clarify what the proposed event consists in and how the intended audience stands to benefit from the event. In addition to this project description, members of the LRC are asked to provide a budget for the activity alongside a specific monetary request from the LRC as well as a statement indicating whether any funding is sought elsewhere. If space in the LRC is requested, this should be indicated too.

Members who receive funding through this initiative are asked to provide a brief report on their activity that can be used for the LRC website.
