Timeline for the Honours Program

January/February: Departmental review of applications and announcement of decision by email. Once approved, students submit a [Change of Program](#) to BA Honours in Political Science by February 1 to gain entry to the program. *It may be wise to adjust your course load to allow for the demands of the program.*

September: Entry into Political Science 590, Honours Seminar, and development of a Thesis Proposal.

September - November: Students develop a Thesis Proposal to send to potential supervisors for consideration. An accepting supervisor sends a completed *Honours Supervisory Agreement* to the Director of Honours.

December: A B+ or better in Political Science 590 is required to graduate to 591, the Honours Thesis.

January - March: Political Science 591, Honours Thesis. Regular meetings of supervisor and student to consider repeated drafts of the Thesis.

Early April: 10,000-word Honours Thesis submitted for grading, with final grade submitted by mid-April. A grade of B+ or better is required to graduate with an Honours degree.
