## **Timeline for the Honours Program**

January/February: Departmental review of applications and announcement of decision by email. Once approved, students submit a Change of Program to BA Honours in Political Science by February 1 to gain entry to the program. *Space is limited. Meeting these requirements does not guarantee entry.* September of Final Year: Entry into Political Science 590, Honours Seminar. It may be wise to adjust your course load to allow for the demands of the program.

**September - November:** Students develop a Thesis Proposal to send to potential supervisors for consideration. An accepting supervisor sends a completed *Honours Supervisory Agreement* to the Director of Honours.

**December:** A B+ or bettter in Political Science 590 is required to graduate to 591, the Honours Thesis. **January - March:** Political Science 591, Honours Thesis. Regular meetings of supervisor and student to consider repeated drafts of the Thesis.

**Early April:** Students submit a 10,000-word Honours Thesis for grading, with a final grade submitted by mid- April. A grade of B+ or better is required to graduate with an Honours degree.
